1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
- 1.4 Appendix T will apply.
- 1.5 [NP]The penalty for breach of a class rule may. At the discretion of protest committee, be less than disqualification.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be displayed on the official notice board located on the RVYC Veranda.

3. COMMUNICATION

3.1 The official notice board is located on the RVYC Veranda

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to members and guests in the following classes:
 - Optimist
 - Open Monohull
 - Hobie/Dart18
 - Open Multihull Class and similar boats with spinnakers
- 4.2 All entries must have a unique sail number.

8 VENUE

8.1 Racing will take place in the water immediately off the Royal Varuna Yacht Club.

9 COURSE

9.1 The courses to be sailed will be displayed on the official notice board.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 For Multihull classes RRS44.1 is changed to the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 Appendix A will Apply.
- 11.2 3 Races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race score as below:
 - (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score.
 - (b) When from 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.4 RVYC Handicaps as published will be used.

12 PRIZES

- 12.1 Prizes will be given as follow:
 - Over all $1^{st} 3^{rd}$ of each class will be given.

13 PRIVACY INFORMATION

13.1 By registering for the race, You allow RVYC to use your personal information, including photographs, for administrative, instructional and safety purposes. You also agree that RVYC may share photographs of you with you and the other participants of your course and within the RVYC community, including on our social media. If you do not wish to have your photograph shared, please notify our reception when you register. RVYC will never use your personal information or photograph for advertising without your prior permission.

14. LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

- 14.1 The Organizing Authority and all their officers, members and volunteers do not accept liability for loss of life or property, or personal injury or damage caused by or arising out of the event. Competitors take part in the event at their own risk.
- 14.2 The establishment of the notice of race and the sailing instructions in no way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibilities of competitors being solely and entirely responsible for the management of their boats before, during and after the championship.



- 14.3 Competitors shall maintain their boats in a safe and seaworthy condition.
- 14.4 A competitor shall be of good health and a competent sailor capable of racing the dinghy in open water in all conditions, including strong winds.
- 14.5 At-fault occurrences to other boats are the responsibility of the competitor. Competitors are not covered by any liability insurance provided by the organizing authority and should provide their own coverage for personal goods and liability protection. The organizing authority recommends that competitors consult their own insurance carriers to ensure they are covered at this event and regarding additional personal liability insurance coverage.
- 14.6 A competitor is advised to have personal accident and health insurance that covers him while attending the event and while racing.
- 14.7 To the fullest extent permitted by law, each competitor agrees to indemnify and hold, the Host, organizing authority, owners, affiliates, officers, employees, agents, members, volunteers, committee persons and race officials, acting in their official capacities, harmless from any claim arising from a competitor's acts or omissions.
