## SAILING INSTRUCTION

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Appendix T will apply. The Arbitrator's opinion is final.

### 2. NOTICES TO COMPETITOR

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board (ONB) at the Veranda.

### 3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Any change to the Sailing Instructions will be posted before 09.00 on the day it will take effect.

### 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flagpole in front of the RVYC Beach Bar.
- 4.2 When Code flag "AP" is displayed ashore with a committee boat start, '1 minute' is Replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in the race signal AP. This changes the RRS AP RACE Signal.

### 7. THE COURSES

- 7.1 The courses will be displayed on the ONB before the first race commences.

### 8. MARKS

- 8.1 Marks of the course may be Yellow, Orange, Red, Blue and/or Black inflatable marks. Marks can also be Islands, buoys, and/or other marks as displayed on the ONB.

### 9. THE START

- 9.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying and orange flag on the race committee vessel and Pin end.
- 9.2 [NP][DP] Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during start sequences for other classes.



## **10. THE FINISH**

- 10.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the race committee vessel with orange flag Pin end.

## **11. SCORE**

- 11.1 One race are required to be completed to constitute the event.

## **12. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS**

- 12.1 Hearing request form are available at the Race Office.
- 12.2 For each class, the protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later.
- 12.3 RRS 60.2(a)(1) is changes to: "if the protestor is a boat, she shall hail 'Protest' at the first reasonable opportunity. She shall inform the race committee at the finishing line immediately after finishing of the boat/s being protested or as soon as practicable after she retires." To inform the race committee of the boat/s being protested, the boat intending to protest shall approach the starboard side of the race committee vessel.

## **13. [NP][DP] EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT**

- 13.1 Hobie and Dart Fleet will have crew minimum weight check before the race.
